Violin

The score is written for violin in treble clef, key of D major (two sharps), and 3/4 time. It consists of four staves. The first staff begins with a repeat sign and contains a sequence of eighth notes with triplets. The second staff continues the melody with slurs and triplets, ending with a repeat sign. Notes:

1. Olav plays open strings to make double stops as much as possible, generally on the upper string from the fingered note.
2. The second time through the A part half the group can play measures 5-8 up one octave for contrast.
